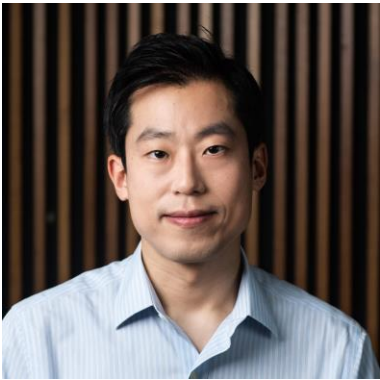

2. Go to **'My Timetable'** to use the Allocate+ system to preference class times

3. Classes are then allocated automatically with personal timetable released **12pm 03/02/2025**

Some Tips

- ❑ Know which program you are in
- ❑ Check the requirements of your program
- ❑ Use the study plan
- ❑ When you are developing your study plan, select courses you are interested in; and then for each course:
 - Checking its availability; please note that some courses are NOT offered in every year
 - Checking its prerequisites (particularly for structure courses); it's the students' responsibility to make sure they have met all the prerequisites.
 - Level 7 courses are generally the most constrained ones.
- ❑ Research project is 1-year or 1-semester long
- ❑ To help you perform better in your research project, you are encouraged to enrol in [CIVL7518: Research Methods for Engineers](#) (offered in Sem 2) in your first year if this is compatible with your program requirements.
- ❑ **UQ has zero tolerance for academic misconduct (e.g., plagiarism, use of AI unless stated otherwise in the course profile)**

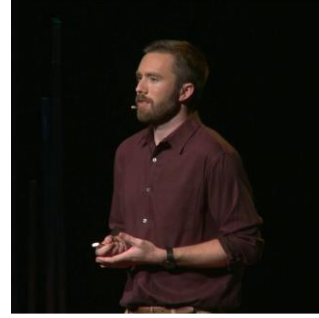
